Dear Adrian Rowe

Thank you for the great news of our successful CEP grant.

In response to your letter SCAGI would like to inform you of our latest grant funding arrangements and our project situation. Since submitting the CEP grant application, we have received a State Govt grant for a specific part of our site. The area is west of the beach access track to the private property boundaries to the north and west. This area of the site is only 20% of the overall site area.

We intend to spend this DPIPWE \$5K Weeds Action Fund Grant on mulching the leftover area of burnt gorse then follow up with treating the regrowth of weeds in that area.

Our submitted budget to you already included an existing Landcare Grant for \$5K and is for the whole site of 50ha.

The CEP grant we intend to spend on the other areas of the site. Mostly on a not burnt tall gorse invested corner to the north of the other two sites which needs to be mulched first then treated.

Phil Thompson from DPIPWE referred a new landowner who borders this area to us to deal with the problem. This final bit of gorse eradication is dependent on the CEP grant. Our yearly community event and field day will of course also be part of our agreement. Also, the other weeds mentioned in our submission will need special attention during the year.

We hope this scenario will not impact on our CEP grant and look forward to your reply so we can budget for this coming year.

For better clarity of the situation I include an aerial photograph with the areas marked.
